The next three years were a whirlwind—the L.A.-based couple welcomed their first child, son Hudson, in 2011, and Curtis, a renowned chef, opened Maude in Beverly Hills. On a much-needed Italian holiday, Curtis gave Lindsay a love letter about their relationship that ended with "Will you marry me?"

The couple remembered a vacation to Majorca and their friend Marietta Salas, who owns a majestic Arabian horse farm on the island (Ganadería Ses Planes), and in 2013 they tied the knot at a black-tie affair on the property. "A destination wedding meant giving up control of every little detail, which we happily did," says Lindsay. SoCal-based planner Lisa Vorce, who specializes in romantic destination affairs, took the reins for the Old World European fairy tale. As Lindsay spent the day getting ready, Curtis prepared the meal inspired by local traditions and recipes and made a carrot cake (Lindsay's favorite) decorated with wildflowers from the gardens. "While he was mixing the batter, we each stirred in a wish for the future," says Lindsay. "And now every year we make this cake and make a new wish." The newlyweds celebrated their first anniversary in Curtis' native Australia, eagerly awaiting the arrival of their second child in September.
